### **Increasing Social Awareness in Adults with Autism**

- In the past, children were taught table manners, how to dress, and social “appropriateness” in their homes and school rooms Now, our children are expected to pick up on these skills naturally
- Some individuals with autism, young and old, do not naturally adopt “expected” nonverbal
