parents agree on joint custody, the court must order it unless the court determines that joint custody is not in the best interests of the child When deciding, judges must state on the record their reasons for granting or denying the request Judges may consider joint custody without a parent's

request

the parents' home without their permission unless it can show the parents are unfit Both parents of a child have equal say in the child's life, unless there is a court order limiting the rights of the parents (through legal custody and parenting time, for example) The rights of parents include decision-making about everyday matters

If both parents have custody of a child and one of them dies, the other alone shall have custody If both parents die, the court shall, upon notification by the social welfare committee or when the fact otherwise becomes known, entrust custody to one or two specially appointed custodians
