In your LDAP, create a group called BAMAdministrator (this already exists if you are using the security realm that comes with WebLogic. Assign users to this group. Then in Oracle Enterprise Manager, expand Business Activity Monitoring -> right click BamServer (bam server name) -> click Security -> click Application Roles.
