Because of their specialized training, social workers play a critical role on the team—communicating with patients and families.

Palliative care social workers play an instrumental role in helping patients with life-threatening illnesses come to terms with the difficulties of disease and the prospect of death. In most cases, this requires social workers to guide patients and their families through a mix of shock, disbelief and sadness.

Some hospice and palliative care social workers work for companies that exclusively provide home care to patients with terminal or incurable and debilitating diseases. Social workers in these settings help patients and their families set up the proper structures for effective home care and ensure that clients get the medical, psychological and social care they need outside a medical setting in their own homes.

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The Center to Advance Palliative Care (CAPC) and the Social Work Hospice and Palliative Care Network (SWHPN) gathered a dozen palliative care social workers to explore challenges with their role on palliative care teams. Many argue that the role of the palliative care social worker is particularly critical in community settings, where improving quality of life for patients depends on care coordination and navigating patient/family/provider dynamics.

Hospice and palliative care social workers may find themselves in any number of different work environments. Some, for instance, have their own offices in private practice, or they may work at state or government facilities. They may also work in schools, hospitals, military settings, community centers, and home care or nursing care facilities.

Social Workers in Hospice and Palliative Care Hospice and palliative care social workers spend much of their time directly with clients in home visits, inpatient settings, or office consultations. A great deal of driving to visit clients and some off-hour emergency coverage may be required, particularly in hospice. Social workers also make phone calls to check in with clients and locate resources.
